



Ordeal Candidate Frequently Asked Questions

What time does the weekend start?

- Registration opens at 7 PM on Friday.
- Plan for significant traffic enroute to all of our camps on a Friday night!
- If you arrive earlier than 7:00 PM you may have to wait for registration to open, but because of traffic it's better to be earlier than late.
- You must be in camp to register by 9:00 PM

What time does the weekend end?

- The weekend ends at 10:00 AM on Sunday .
- Before you leave you must clean up any cabin or area that you stayed in.
- You must also check out with registration before you leave.

Can I leave Saturday night or earlier on Sunday morning?

- **NO!** We have lots of stuff to explain, lots of fun activities planned, and lots of stuff to give you Saturday night.
- More is planned for Sunday morning.
- If there are **UNUSUAL** family circumstances you **MUST** make arrangements **PRIOR TO THE WEEKEND** with and receive approval from the Lodge Adviser **BEFORE** the weekend begins (Warren Dressler; 201-853-9028; lodgeadviser@oaix.njbsa.org)

What should I bring with me?

- Parts A & B of your current medical form (be sure if you are under 18 it is signed by your parent or guardian) (a copy of the form is preferred)
- Class "A" uniform (wear to camp)
- Work clothes
- Rain Gear
- Ground Cloth
- Sleeping Bag
- Flashlight

- Toiletries
- Water Bottle
- Insect Repellant
- Tent
- Extra money for the OA Trading Post (see below for more information)

Can I or should I bring food/eating utensils?

No! All food is provided. **If you have special dietary requirements please make prior arrangements by contacting the Lodge Vice-Chief of Inductions at inductions@oaix.njbsa.org.** Please do **this in addition** to checking off any appropriate boxes on the registration form.

Why do I have to and what kind of tent should I bring?

Not all of our camps have enough cabin or lean-to space for all attendees so we ask everyone (members too) to bring a personal backpacking tent. Check with your unit leader if you don't have one.

How much does an Induction Weekend cost?

It costs \$60 which includes:

- Your membership fee for the current year (\$15)
- Sash (\$20)
- Handbook (\$5)
- Lodge Flap (\$5)
- Food (\$15)

When are the Induction Weekends?

They are as follows:

- - May 5th 2017 thru May 7th 2017 at Camp No-Be-Bo-Sco
- - June 2nd 2017 thru June 4th 2017 at Camp Turrell
- - September 22nd 2017 thru September 24th 2017 at Camp Yaw Paw

Why should I bring extra money?
