Schedule for the Day

8:00 AM - 8:30 AM All Town hosts go directly to station area (follow map) for set-up. Scoring clip boards will be dropped off to you.

9 AM Troop Sleds report to the starting area for Gear Check. Each sled will be given a score

card, map and assigned a station to start at.

9-10 AM Webelos Sleds report to the starting area for Gear Check. Each sled will be given a

score card, map and assigned a station to start at.

Sleds can visit stations in any order after that.

• Sleds are not required to visit every station

highest point total wins so you have a better shot if you make it to as many as possible.

11:45-12:15 PM All Towns closed for lunch

12:15-2:15 PM All Towns reopen

2:30 – All Score Cards must be turned in @ District Table.

3:00pm Final scoring immediately followed by Awards Ceremony

Note – As sleds finish they must go to the District Table report scores. Remember if there is a tie for highest score, the earlier sled to check in their score wins.

List of Mandatory Equipment

All of the following equipment will be checked at Check-in and points will be deducted from maximum 10 that can be awarded for missing items. Individual items must be with EACH scout on sled and patrol items must be on the sled. Each sled should have no less than 4 participants and no more than 8. (Note – Tenderfoot sleds may have 4- 8 Tenderfoot Scouts and one non-participating guide accompanying the sled.)

- Sled (no wheels)
- Lunch and water for each participant
- Rain gear for each participant (Bring regardless of weather or risk losing points!!!)
- Blindfold for each participant (can use neckerchief or triangular bandage)
- Triangular bandage for each participant
- First aid kit (for patrol)
- Leather or cloth bag approx 12" x 12" with drawstring to hold nuggets. No plastic bags!! (for patrol)
- Clipboard, paper and pen or pencil (for patrol)
- Compass (for patrol)
- Fire building material tinder, kindling and 2 or 3 pieces of fuel wood. All materials must be natural and must have enough to keep fire burning. NO DRYER LINT, VASELINE, ACCELERANTS or COMERCIAL FIRESTARTERS!!! No batteries/steel wool.) (for patrol)
- Fire bucket (Water for fire buckets will be provided)
- Rope for Knots four 10 foot lengths (for patrol)
- Four poles each 3 to 6 feet long (for patrol) This is not needed for WEBELOS Sleds
- Patrol (sled) Cheer
- 2 long poles (to make a stretcher)
- Patrol flag

Scouts with appropriate clothing and boots for weather (Raingear required regardless.)

Scouts not dressed appropriately for the weather will be turned away!

Awards will be given for 3 top sleds based on point value earned and top 3 WEBELOS sleds based on point value.
