

INTRODUCTION TO CUB SCOUT GROWTH

Cub Scout membership growth comes about in three ways:

1. **Retain** boys and leaders who are now registered for a longer period of time.
2. **Recruit** new boys and adults into existing packs.
3. **Organize** new and reorganize dropped Cub Scout packs.

The Cub Scout roundup provides opportunities for growth in youth retention and recruitment and in new unit Organization.

January–March Reregister the maximum number of boys and adults in every pack.

April–June Select fall leadership for existing dens and new dens to be organized. Provide Fast Start training for all new pack leadership.

June–August Conduct the annual Pack Program Planning Conference.

August–September Conduct a roundup of youth and adults. Provide Fast Start training for all new pack leaders and den orientation meetings for boys and parents.

October–November All new leaders participate in Basic Leader Training.
