In 1899, Colonel Robert Baden-Powell, was sent to South Africa to raise a regiment in the region surrounding the town of Mafeking.

A few months after his arrival the Boer War erupted. A large Boer force of 9,000 men advanced on the town of Mafeking defended by Colonel Baden Powell with only 1,251 combatants. During the 217 day siege the Boer forces fired 20,000 shells into the town and nearly 326 of B-P's force were killed. His heroic and successful defense of this small town of some 8000 inhabitants against overwhelming odds was an inspiration to his country and resulted in his promotion to Major General.
