Bear Adventure: Fur, Feathers, and Ferns

- Complete the hiking requirement and plant/animal identification (#1).
- Complete the endangered/extinct animal identification (#2).
- Complete the plant study (#3).

Bear Adventure: Bear Necessities

- Camp overnight (#1).
- Campfire show and participate in a song or skit (#2).
- Make a list of items you should take along on your campout (#3).
- Make a list of group equipment (#4).
- Plan a cooked lunch or dinner with your Den (#5).
- Help an adult cook a different meal from #5 (#6).
- Help set up a tent (#7).
- Tie two half hitches and explain (#8).

Bear Elective Adventure: A Bear Goes Fishing

- Discover three types of fishes in your area. Draw a color picture of each fish, record what each one likes to eat, and describe what sort of habitat each likes (#1).
- Learn about your local fishing regulations (#2).
- Learn about fishing equipment, and make a simple fishing pole. Practice casting at a target 30 feet away. Teach what you have learned to someone in your family, another Scout, or one of your friends (#3).
- Using the skills you have learned, fish for one hour (#4).
